

Notice is hereby given by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of East Hanover, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania that the Board of Supervisors will consider a proposed Ordinance for adoption at the regularly scheduled public meeting of the Board of Supervisors of the Township of East Hanover on October 17, 2017, at 7:30 p.m. at the East Hanover Township Municipal Building, at 8848 Jonestown Road, Grantville, Pennsylvania, 17028. The title of the proposed Ordinance is:

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING RULES AND REGULATIONS IN THE PARKS AND RECREATION AREAS OF EAST HANOVER TOWNSHIP, DAUPHIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING PROCEDURES AND FEES FOR THE USE THEREOF, AND IMPOSING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATIONS THEREOF.

A summary of the proposed Ordinance is as follows:

The purpose of this Ordinance is to provide rules and regulations for the use of and conduct in the parks and recreation areas of East Hanover Township. The Ordinance is meant to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of East Hanover Township as well as the Parks and wildlife. Additionally, the Ordinance sets forth the rules and procedures for reserving the Parks, picnic pavilions, or other facilities within East Hanover Township. Finally, the Ordinance provides an enforcement section for any violations of the rules and regulations. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its enactment.
