

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Supervisors of the Township of East Hanover, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania, intends to consider for adoption and to vote upon enactment of an Ordinance entitled and summarized hereinafter at its regularly scheduled meeting to be held on January 7, 2019 at 7:30 p.m., at the East Hanover Township Municipal Building. The title of the proposed Ordinance is:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST HANOVER, DAUPHIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING AN EARNED INCOME TAX CREDIT FOR QUALIFYING VOLUNTEERS SERVING THE GRANTVILLE VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY IN EAST HANOVER TOWNSHIP.

A summary of the proposed Ordinance is as follows:

The Township elects to establish an earned income tax credit of \$600.00 annually for Qualifying Volunteers serving the Grantville Fire Company, pursuant to Act 172 of 2016. The Ordinance and accompanying resolution sets forth a definition of Qualifying Volunteers, the procedure for certification, and an appeal process for applicants.
