

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Supervisors of the Township of East Hanover, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania, intends to consider for adoption and to vote upon enactment of an Ordinance entitled and summarized hereinafter at its regularly scheduled meeting to be held on March 5, 2019 at 7:30 p.m., at the East Hanover Township Municipal Building. The title of the proposed Ordinance is:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST HANOVER, DAUPHIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, IMPLEMENTING THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE LOCAL TAXPAYERS BILL OF RIGHTS BY ADOPTING RULES AND REGULATIONS, ADOPTING A DISCLOSURE STATEMENT, ADOPTING A FORM OF TAXPAYER PETITION, AND ADOPTING ADMINISTRATIVE APPEAL PROCEDURES.

A summary of the proposed Ordinance is as follows:

The Township elects to adopt the Local Taxpayers Bill of Rights (“LTBR”), 53 Pa.C.S. §§ 8421 et seq., which requires political subdivisions levying certain local eligible taxes (“Eligible Taxes”) to adopt rules and regulations for practice, procedure, and administration in the audit, assessment, appeal, determination, and collection of such Eligible Taxes.
